Dear Friend with an Unplanned Pregnancy,

I write to you today because I understand where you are... so many thoughts and emotions. How do I know? I was in your same shoes. I was scared, ashamed, embarrassed, and simply wanted it not to be true. I remember the thoughts that raced through my head.

Why me?

I am a student. I cannot afford a baby.

I will have to change the plans I had.

I don't even know who the father is!

What will everyone think of me?

Although my story may not match yours, I hope that the lessons I have learned will help. You see, I was a recent college graduate who could have changed my plans of graduate school, gotten a job, or just taken classes parttime. I could not see any options; I just wanted my "problem" to go away.

Don't get me wrong. I loved babies, but I was not ready for one. I was dating two different guys. So, when that pregnancy test came back positive, I didn't know what to do or who to contact. I found a phone number for an abortion clinic.

I aborted my child 33 years ago.

And you know what? I still am ashamed, embarrassed, and so entirely regretful. My heart aches. My "problem" did not go away that day. The pain in my heart began and will remain with me forever. I cannot change my decision. You can. Do not repeat my mistake.

There are options. There is a pregnancy center waiting to help you face your challenge. You were given this child at this very time in your life for a reason.

Choose life!

I want you to kiss the face of your child. I want you to know that if you choose life, everything will be okay. If your circumstances don't allow you to keep your child, then consider adoption. There is simply no greater gift than that! This child in your womb is bound to bring much joy to you and/or another family.

Take a deep breath. You are not alone on this journey. Do not make any quick decisions that you will regret. I wish someone would have said these things to me.

I want more for you. Pray. God will show you the way. Jesus' mother, Mary, was scared too. But God showed her the way. Everything will be okay. I promise.
