# A Change in a Moment

Have you ever witnessed a life fundamentally change in a single moment? As a Client Advocate at Pregnancy Center Plus for 15 years, I've had the profound privilege of seeing it happen countless times!

As we know, the Holy Spirit's timing is always impeccable. Last month, Kayla\* heard our radio ad only once, but that was all it took for her to cancel an abortion appointment scheduled for the very next day.

Kayla walked into the Center that morning. She sat across from me, a tangle of fear and relief in her eyes. She thought she was about 10 weeks pregnant, but as we spoke, and it became clear why she was so distraught: she was using heroin and fentanyl. Her greatest fear wasn't continuing the pregnancy, but that she might have already irrevocably harmed her baby. She saw abortion as her only choice.

Then came the ultrasound. Not 10 weeks, but 17 weeks. And not one baby, but twins. Our immediate focus shifted. We wasted no time connecting her directly with the HOPE program at Good Samaritan Hospital for immediate treatment and the specialized prenatal care she so desperately needed. From there, she'll transition to the First Step program for long-term residential recovery.

Kayla remains in my daily prayers. She's now embracing the possibility of a bright future as the sober mother to two precious lives. I often reflect on the saying, "A person comes into your life for a reason, a season, or a lifetime." More than ever, I feel as equally blessed as Kayla and her twins to have had our paths intersect at such a pivotal moment.

## The Next Right Decision

I left our apartment with only a few clothes and my purse. A few days later, in my desperate online search for abortion information, God led me to PCPlus. I immediately called their office and learned of all their free services. Free was key. I had little money. I came in for an appointment that very afternoon. The Client Advocate was gentle, compassionate, and caring. I saw my 9-week-old unborn baby move on the ultrasound screen. I heard her fast heartbeat. I exhaled, knowing I had come to the right place.

During our long-term relationship, my fiancé never laid a hand on me. I did not realize I was being abused. A couple of years back, I began to recognize the signs. I prayed many times for a physical beating so that I would be believed. By my family and friends. By my pastor. Highly regarded in his career, his public image was that of a good guy. Behind closed doors, he was a controlling abuser. Emotional. Financial. Sexual. And now he was pressuring me to get an abortion.


For months, I had prayed for the strength to leave him. God seemed distant. Depression and a growing list of health issues mounted. Then God, in His mercy, provided a way for me. My pregnancy, as it turns out, was the push I needed to leave him and choose a new path for the sake of my baby. One step at a time, I began to make the next right decision with the help of PCPlus. My first decision: to keep my baby, even if it meant raising her alone.

Next, I attended the free parenting classes offered at PCPlus. I met other first-time expectant parents. We encouraged each other. This gave me the confidence to believe I could be a good mother.

Emotional healing has been a process. Years of trauma have affected my body, brain, and sleep. PTSD. I have taken advantage of the psychotherapy and neurotherapy offered in the lower level at PCPlus. I have begun to feel real relief.

I am still a work in progress. God is healing me from the inside out, helping me to envision a good life for my daughter and me. The incredible folks at PCPlus have walked alongside me the entire way. Someday soon, I hope to introduce them to the greatest blessing of my new life, my baby girl.
